- You understand that full liability of any veterinary fees incurred after the adoption date remain your liability, unless the cat is part of the ManxSPCA foster scheme.
- You understand that although we tell you everything we know about the cat, we do not always have a complete history and therefore cannot guarantee behaviour etc.
- The ManxSPCA is here to advise you on any aspect of caring for the cat. It may take six months or more for the cat to settle in.
- If you live in rented accommodation, The ManxSPCA will need written permission from your landlord that your tenancy agreement allows pets before you adopt the cat. This must state you have permission for the number of animals you have currently **plus** the cat(s) you are looking to adopt.
